## Legal competitors merge: Siegfried Rivera + Hyman & Mars

Two long-time Miami law firms that operate in the construction and real estate sectors have decided to join forces. The merger combines Hyman & Mars, with 10 attorneys, and Siegfried Rivera, Lerner, De La Torre & Sobel, with 28 atttorneys. Siegfried Rivera ranked 42 on the Business Journal's 2013 list of the Top 150 Largest Law Firms in South Florida.

The new firm will launch July 1 and be called Siegfried, Rivera, Hyman, Lerner, De La Torre, Mars & Sobel, P.A.
